

# **Heritage Scholarship Designed for You**

#### SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

Heritage Federal Credit Union is committed to supporting our members in efforts to continue education – and this scholarship honors that commitment.

Each year, Heritage will award 10 students with a \$2,000 scholarship. The total scholarship will be distributed in increments of \$1,000 over the student's first and second year of school (at the beginning of each fall semester). Scholarship money will be deposited directly into the student's Heritage account and can be used for tuition, books, fees, room and board, gas, or other related expenses.

Please note that each year there will be 2 scholarships dedicated to immediate family members of Heritage employees. Students that accept a full ride scholarship from any other source should notify Heritage and decline the Heritage Scholarship Designed for You. If the student does not maintain full-time enrollment after the first year, the remaining reward will not be awarded.

#### SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

The following requirements must be met:

- 1. The student must hold a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.30 (or a B+ average).
- 2. The student must be at senior at a high school within a county that has an operating Heritage branch. A complete list of branch locations can be found at heritagefederal.org/locations.

### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

The following materials are required:

- **1.** The application should be typed and completed by the student, parent/guardian, and school official. If not typed, handwritten applications must be completed in ink pen and scanned.
- 2. The student must include 1 professional letter of recommendation written an employee from school or community organization within which the student is involved.
- **3.** The student must submit a video (less than 2 minutes) introducing oneself and explaining all future educational goals and how the scholarship would help accomplish those goals. The student will not be judged based on the production quality of the video.
- **4.** The student must submit a typed response to the prompts below in less than 2 pages (double-spaced).
  - **a.** Describe your participation and involvement in the community and how it has shaped your perspective.
  - **b.** Describe a personal achievement that has made you proud.
  - c. How would you change or improve the products/services that Heritage provides?

Please submit all required materials as PDF files in one email to **scholarship@heritagefederal.org** by 11:59 pm on February 28, 2023.

The student is responsible for ensuring all required materials are included in the email. Incomplete applications will be deemed ineligible.

#### NOTIFICATION AND RECOGNITION OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients will be notified directly by a member of the Heritage Marketing team. On the first Monday in April, the names of the winning students will be posted to the Heritage website: **heritagefederal.org**. Recipients of the scholarship will be recognized during the school baccalaureate night and check presentation ceremony.

The names and photographs of the scholarship recipients may be utilized by Heritage for public relations purposes. By applying for the scholarship, students agree to these terms.

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

- Recipients are encouraged to like/follow all Heritage social media channels and post/share pictures of the check presentation ceremony on personal social media channels.
- Recipients must maintain initial eligibility requirements through the duration of the scholarship period.
- Recipients must self-report documentation (transcript for GPA) to show that GPA requirements have been
  met before receiving the final \$1,000 deposit at the beginning of the 2<sup>nd</sup> fall semester. If the GPA
  requirement has not been met, the 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of the scholarship will not be awarded.
